## Seaview Newsletter

The **Point of Woods fireworks** are scheduled for this Wednesday July 4<sup>th</sup> after sundown. The Association is encouraging all our residents and their guests to watch the fireworks from the Seaview boat basin or bay beach. Please bring your beach chairs and drinks to enjoy this special night and event. We will not be allowing glass bottles or dogs into the bay beach.



**Garbage Pick-up** this week will be today (Monday) and Thursday. Tony's garbage will attempt to pick up recyclables on both Monday and Thursday, because Wednesday (7/4) is a holiday and there won't be any garbage service. Weekend garbage pick-ups start this Saturday July 7<sup>th</sup>.

The Seaview **building moratorium** began yesterday and will be in effect through Labor Day. Please request your contractor perform needed maintenance only. Major construction is not allowed until after Labor Day.

Seaview's **Security** began this past Friday 6/30. Seaview's security guards will be on the Seaview streets on all Friday and Saturday nights throughout the summer. They begin at 8 pm and are on duty until 2 am. They will be looking to control the noise level of the transient traffic through Seaview, enforce bicycling laws including proper lights, bells and safe operation of

their bikes, render emergency first aid, respond to calls for service by our residents, etc.

Seaview's **beach security** will be on the beach on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. They will be on the beach from 10 am until 4 pm. They will be enforcing Seaview's rules and regulations relating to (1) no dogs on the beach during lifeguard hours, (2) no alcohol or large coolers on the beach, (3) no loud music or disruptive behavior, etc.

**Seaview's Security** can be reached during their hours at **631-583-9108**. If you have a problem or concern, please contact them directly.

**Dogs** - Please remember that your dogs must be on a leash at all times. Please clean up and pick up your dog's waste. This is State law and will be enforced by the Suffolk County Police and our security.

**Safety** - A major concern of the Seaview Association is the safety and security of all our residents. We understand there have been several reports of unknown people trying to enter residents' homes at night. We don't know if these people have just been mistaken or if they have more nefarious intentions. Should this happen to you, we recommend that you call **911** immediately and report it. You can then call Seaview's security during the weekend (Friday and Saturday nights) at 631-583-9108. Please also let the Association know about any unusual event, by emailing us at [seaviewfeedback@gmail.com](mailto:seaviewfeedback@gmail.com), so that we can follow-up.

**Bikes** – Every bike is required to have a light for bicycling at night. Bikes are also required to have bells. Both of these items are required by State law. Our security team will stop people who are riding without this equipment and Suffolk County police officers will also be issuing summons for violators which endanger people walking on our streets.

**Carts** - Contractors are only supposed to be driving their golf carts in

the morning to their jobs and back to their shops at the end of the day.

They are always supposed to be driving in a safe and slow manner (5 mph) and stopping at each corner . Any violations or unsafe

driving by a contractor should be brought to the Association's attention.

Please let us know when and where the incident occurred, the respective contractor,

their Islip permit number (from the front of their cart) and / or Ocean Beach permit number. Pictures are appreciated.

The **beach lifeguards** in Seaview are on duty daily now through Labor Day from 9 am till 5 pm. The Seaview lifeguard stands are on E Street and on weekends on B Street too. The lifeguards in Seaview stayed till 6 pm this past weekend based on the exceptionally hot weather. On extraordinarily hot days a decision will be made as to keeping the beach lifeguards on duty later.

The **Fire Island Ferries** has started a 6:10 am boat out of Seaview on Monday through Friday. The ferry company is looking for your comments, suggestions and complaints.
